RULES AND REGULATIONS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

The tee times will run from April 3rd/4th through September 25th/26th, 2010. Those interested in a seasonal tee time must notify Public Golf Associates in writing, on this form, by March 20th, 2010. **Public Golf Associates reserves the right to deny a seasonal tee time to any group at its discretion. Please read the following rules and regulations carefully.**

Please declare a captain and co-captain on the front page of the tee time request form. In case of any changes or problems, the captain will be notified and it will be his or her responsibility to contact the players in his or her group. If the captain cannot be reached the co-captain will be notified. It is required that at least two of the members of each group requesting a tee time be City of Racine residents. If there are any tee times remaining after the March 20th deadline, groups not meeting the City of Racine requirement may apply for a time.

The cost of a tee time will be \$5.50 per week plus a one time \$7.00 processing fee.
Saturdays and Sundays have 26 weeks at \$150.00.

TEE TIME RESERVATION FEES ARE DUE BY THE FIRST WEEK OF PLAY OR EARLIER
(Saturday, April 3rd and Sunday, April 4th)

Fees not paid by the due date will result in cancellation of the tee time for the following week. Tee time fees not paid by the second week will result in cancellation for the rest of the year.

The tee time holder must notify the golf shop in writing by closing time Thursday before the weekend if the tee time will not be used. There will be a form provided in the golf shop to use when a tee time is to be canceled. **If the tee time goes unused or is not filled by a foursome without written notification of these tee time changes, the group will forfeit their tee time for the following weekend. A second offense will result in losing the seasonal tee time. In this case, the reservation fee for the remaining dates will be refunded.**

****You are not guaranteed a tee time because you have had a time in the past years.****

We will be leaving some open times for the general public to use on weekends. This, unfortunately, could lead to some groups losing their tee times.

****As always, the speed of play will be monitored and strictly enforced.****

****ALL GROUPS granted a seasonal tee time before 8:00AM will be required to play the front nine in less than two hours and the entire eighteen in less than four hours. The time clock will be the determining factor of whether the group may continue on the back nine. Any group teeing off prior to 8:00AM that does not complete the front nine in less than two hours, "and is unreasonably behind pace", will be asked to go to the golf shop for a refund for the holes not played. Time cards with a faster pace rating will be used for groups teeing off before 8:00AM.** The seasonal tee time holder will be required to follow all of the regulations regarding the time card and time clock system. **Any group granted a seasonal tee time before 8:00AM will be required to play the front nine in less than two hours, and eighteen holes in less than four hours.**

Whether or not a group is playing slow is at the sole discretion of the management. This will be determined through fair and equitable observations. If you feel you were treated unfairly, you should contact a manager as soon as possible. In order to comply with the rules governing slow play and to avoid losing your tee time, your group may want to play a foursome instead of a fivesome. *If your group does elect to play a fivesome, the time schedule is no longer your time standard.* Instead, your group must keep pace with the groups in front of you. At the discretion of management, if your group is not keeping pace on a consistent basis your group will be required to play a foursome and not a fivesome. Remember, that unless your group is the first group off, there are many foursomes and fivesomes in front of your group. Realizing this, please remember to look ahead of your group rather than behind while evaluating your own group's pace.

Please note: The Player Assistant (Ranger) is often misunderstood and viewed by the golfer as a "cop with a watch". Please remember, the Player Assistant is there to assist golfers and to help maintain a "suitable pace of play" so that **ALL GROUPS** can enjoy a timely round of golf **throughout the day**. If you are approached by a Player Assistant and asked to help him maintain the "pace of play", please do not take offense. Communication with all groups is beneficial to the Player Assistant as well as the golfers.

Each member of the group must read and sign this rules sheet and sign the request form. Thank you for your cooperation, and we look forward to serving you in 2010.

I HAVE READ ALL OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS ABOVE AND UNDERSTAND THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF A SEASONAL TEE TIME HOLDER. I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS IS ONLY A REQUEST FOR A TEE TIME AND TEE TIMES WILL BE DETERMINED AFTER ALL REQUESTS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED.
